## Quality neuro therapy care when you need it

HealthSouth Mid America offers the latest technology and a qualified team of therapists to help patients achieve optimum results for an improved quality of life.

To be eligible for admission to the Inpatient Neuro Recovery Center, a patient must be medically stable and require 24-hour medical and nursing supervision. The patient must also be able to actively participate in an intensive rehabilitation program consisting of approximately three hours of therapy per day, at least five days a week. In addition, the patient should have limitations related to self-care, mobility, cognition, communication and/or swallowing to qualify for entry into the program.

## Intense therapy for a variety of conditions

Conditions treated in the inpatient Neuro Recovery Center include:

- Stroke
- Spinal cord injury
- Brain injury
- Multiple sclerosis
- Parkinson's disease
- Motor-neuron disorders
- Polyneuropathy

## Interdisciplinary team approach for optimum results

HealthSouth Mid America's interdisciplinary team approach to rehabilitation provides therapy and education according to the patient's unique diagnosis. The team of specialists include the following:

**Physiatrist** – specialized physician in physical rehab medicine provides team leadership

**Physical therapist** – works on mobility balance and coordination, incorporating safety awareness

**Occupational therapist** – works on daily living skills activities, safety and strengthening

**Speech therapist** – works with patients on cognition, language skills and swallowing problems

**Respiratory therapist** – works with patients on respiratory needs such as trachs and ventilators

**Rehab nursing** – assists in bowel and bladder training, medication management and wound healing -- encourages the patients to utilize skills they learn to be more independent

**Nutrition/dietician** – assists in maintaining optimal nutrition to improve health and strength

**Case management** – helps coordinate care with the patient's treatment team and assist patients and families with discharge planning

**Medical specialist** – wide range of specialists on staff including neurologist, psychologist, urologist, internal medicine, and orthopedic surgeons to assist with the patient's medical and emotional needs

**Family involvement and education:** Families are encouraged to be an integral part of the rehabilitation process, attending and actively participating in therapy sessions and receiving education.
